Can You Make It?

I think every one of you is aware that the EXAM is a very important part of both secondary school and college. They measure the progress you have made in understanding the subject.

I can tell you that exam time made me nervous! I remember when I was in the seventh grade, we had just finished our English exam. We had all left the room heaving a breath of relief, when Mr. Perry, our math teacher, encountered us.

"You can take your math exam now," he announced.

My classmates and I groaned. "But it's scheduled for tomorrow!"

Mr. Perry grinned. "I know you'll make it."

We tried to make excuses. We needed to cram up on what we'd learned in math from Mr. Perry. We needed to get ready. In other words, we didn't believe we could pass the math exam if we took it now.

But Mr. Perry would have none of this nonsense. "Down to the lunch room," he told us. "You'll take your exam there."

Reluctantly we marched into the lunch room and took our exam.

It was another hour of torture. But you know what? Mr. Perry was right. We all passed the exam!

Mr. Perry knew his students. He knew they would pass, and they did.

In the same way, our Heavenly Father knows us. He knows we will pass and enter into glory with Him. The best thing of it all is that His Son took the exam for us. Check these Scriptures: 1 John 2:1, 1 Peter 5:6-7, Hebrews 2:18 and 4:15-16.

As the apostle John writes: "I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life" (1 John 5:13).

Our confidence rests on our faith. You remember what the Lord told the church in Smyrna: "Be faithful, even to the point of death, and I will give you the crown of life" (Revelation 2:10). Our Lord knew Smyrna, like other congregations, was composed of humans, and therefore imperfect. But they had faith. They held on to that faith. They clung to the Lord even when everything else was falling apart around them.

Our Lord knows who belong to Him (2 Timothy 2:19). And He will stand with us even with our weaknesses. The Hebrew writer said, "...We who have fled to take hold of the hope offered to us may be greatly encouraged. We have this hope as an anchor for the soul, firm and secure" (Hebrews 6:18-19).

So take cheer! Hold on to your faith. You'll pass as long as you have faith in our Lord!
