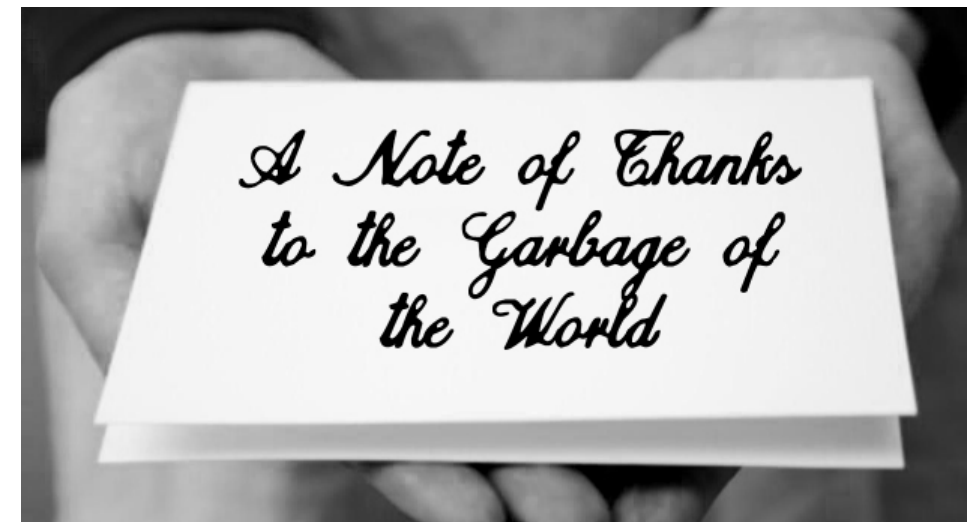

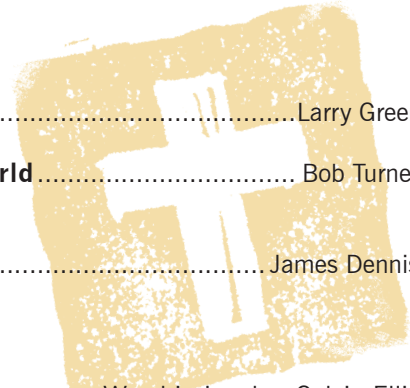

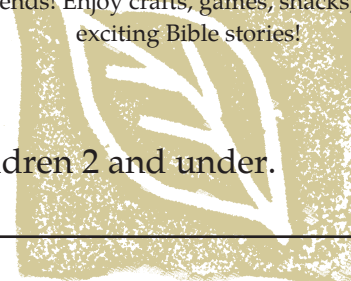

This morning you'll find neither Marilyn nor myself around the church building. Where are we? We're out west in Texas.

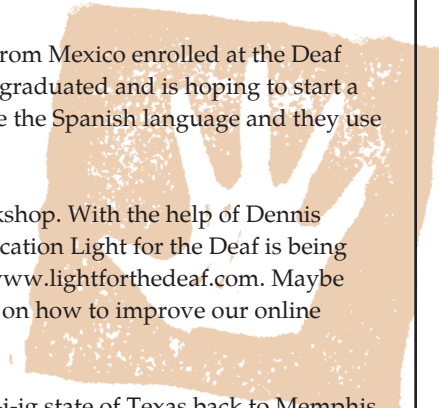

This Workshop is to the deaf ministry as Bible lectureships are to hearing Christians. There is the joy of fellowship and association. Old friendships are renewed and new friendships are made. Lessons are given in the language of signs. You may imagine Marilyn and I are happy to be right there!

One joy I have is that there are now deaf students from Mexico enrolled at the Deaf Department of Sunset Bible Institute. One recently graduated and is hoping to start a ministry in Honduras. Yes, these deaf Mexicans use the Spanish language and they use the Mexican Sign Language

There will be a surprise announcement at the Workshop. With the help of Dennis Wilson, Director of the Deaf Department, my publication Light for the Deaf is being put online.
