**A Way to Pray**

*Be Thou our Vision, O Lord of our heart  
Naught be all else to us, save that Thou art  
Thou our best Thought, by day or by night  
Waking or sleeping, Thy presence our light.*

This traditional Irish hymn is believed to come from the 6th or 8th century. The original is written in first person singular (my vision, my heart, etc.). Since our focus is on praying as a church and for the church and community, using the plural can help us enlarge our perspective.

We live in a time and culture that emphasizes individualism probably more than any other in history. Even though psalmists and early Irish believers wrote using “I” and “my,” they most certainly never thought about their faith as an individualistic, purely personal or private pursuit. Neither should we.

Pray this week for an increased unity among our church. Ask God to show you what you need to learn and do to help that unity grow. Write down the words to this verse (whether in the traditional singular or plural) and carry it around in your pocket or purse or on your phone. Pull it out whenever you have a spare moment and pray. Pray that we as a body will grow in being able to see God and seeing that nothing else matters in comparison to God. Pray that we together as the body of Christ will walk faithfully into the future that God is calling us to.

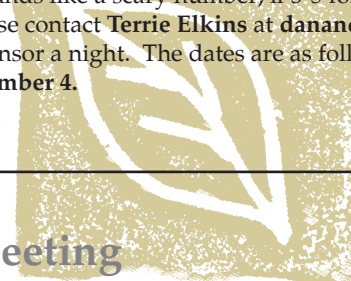
