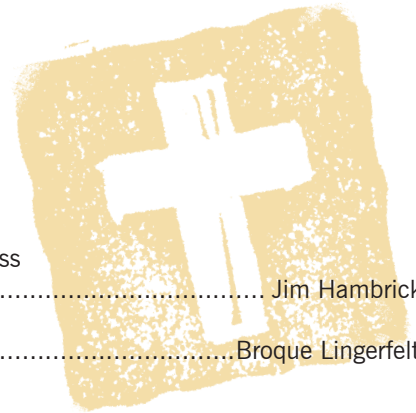

This summer, my family had the amazing opportunity to visit Japan with my grandparents, who are annual missionaries there. Having never been out of the country, my brother (Ben) and I were brand new to the experience. This was a new country with new culture, food, and people.

When we arrived, we settled down before traveling to all sorts of places over the next two weeks. We took so many monorails and trains that I lost count after the second day. We saw Mt. Fuji, huge sulfur vents (smelled horrible), museums, animals, crowded stations, cool shops, and much much more.

What I remember most were the churches we worshipped with. We had two Sundays in Japan and worshipped with the Tachikawa Church and the Ochanomizu Church. Using what little broken Japanese I knew, I spoke with many of the church members and made new friends and acquaintances, creating memories that would last a lifetime.

## Online Bill Pay - An Easy Way to Give
