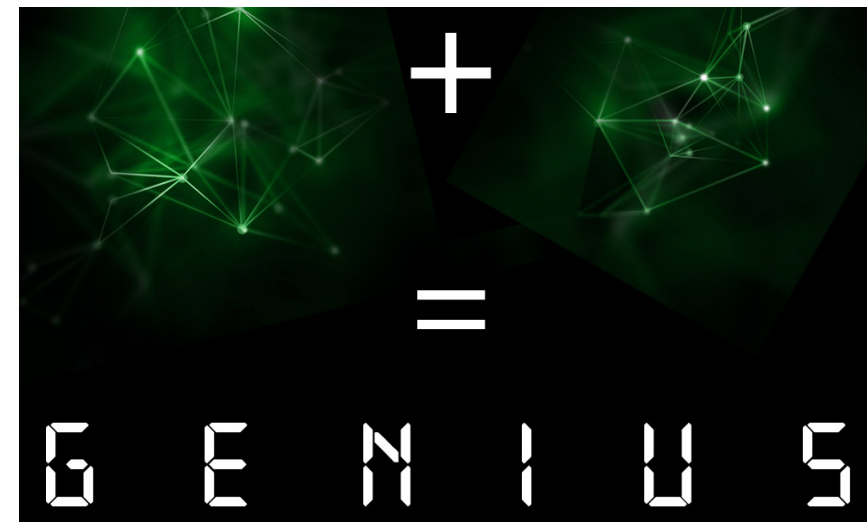

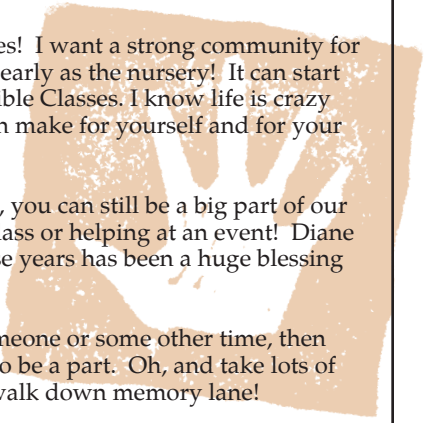
Eighteen Years Later
