**Why We Pray**

“What consumes your mind controls your life.” One of the many reasons to pray is simply that we need to focus our minds on what is real, what is true, what matters. Without this, our lives will soon be controlled by the many distractions and falsehoods that surround us and call for our attention continually.

**A Way to Pray**

*High King of Heaven, our victory won,  
May we reach heaven's joys, O bright heaven's Sun!  
Heart of our own heart, whatever befall,  
Still be our Vision, O Ruler of all.*

This final verse of the Celtic hymn imagines the end of life and eventual victory over death, and the joy of being in the presence of God. God is imaged as the High King, a Celtic term that goes back to pre-historical times, for the king who ruled over the entire country. God is the bright Sun, which gives light and makes life itself possible. God is the “heart of our own heart,” closer to us than we are to ourselves. The hymn prays that we will always keep our eyes set so that God is our vision. Christian faith teaches that God is sovereign and the author of life whether we acknowledge that or not. Our prayer should be to keep God always in our vision so that he becomes our grounding Vision, so that everything we see, we see in the light of His loving power and His light.

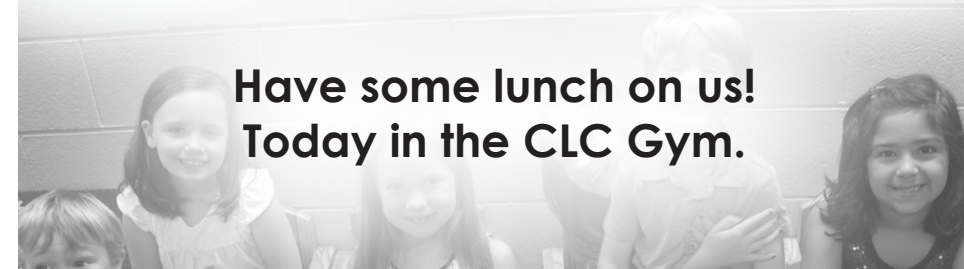

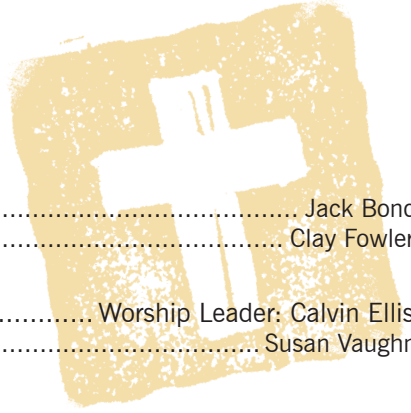

## Encouraging Memories

This past week we had a bit of taste of the past that was sad, but at the same time sweet and encouraging.

Mrs. Dorothy "Dot" Yager passed away after a long illness at Kirby Pines' Retirement Community. Her funeral was last Tuesday in the White Station chapel.

It's hard to believe that Marilyn and I first met her over 40 years ago when we began serving in the deaf ministry at East Frayser Church of Christ. Mrs. Yager had heard that East Frayser now had a full-time deaf ministry, and she decided to bring her deaf daughter Melanie to our services.

If I remember right, at that time Melanie was nearly finished with high school, and was getting ready to go to Gallaudet University, the world's only college geared toward the deaf and hard of hearing.

Through the years we were encouraged as Melanie successfully graduated from Gallaudet and found a nice deaf man, Steve Williams, to marry. They have had two wonderful children through their union. Melanie and Steve are also now full-fledged grandparents.

During the funeral, Melanie took the stand and spoke to the audience in both voice and signs for a few moments. She gave a touching tribute full of gratitude to her mother, Mrs. Yager, for all the things she had done to help make her (Melanie) successful in life. "Thank you, Mom," she managed to end her tribute.

It is a difficult thing for parents when they find that their child is deaf or hard of hearing. Often they don't know what to do. But a few really do fight for their deaf offspring. Mrs. Yager was one. And in this I feel a kindred spirit with Melanie, for my mother also fought for me!

The deaf ministry was moved from East Frayser to White Station in 1998, and we continue to make every effort to provide a spiritual experience for our deaf and hard of hearing.

Thank you, Melanie, for your wonderful tribute to your mother.
