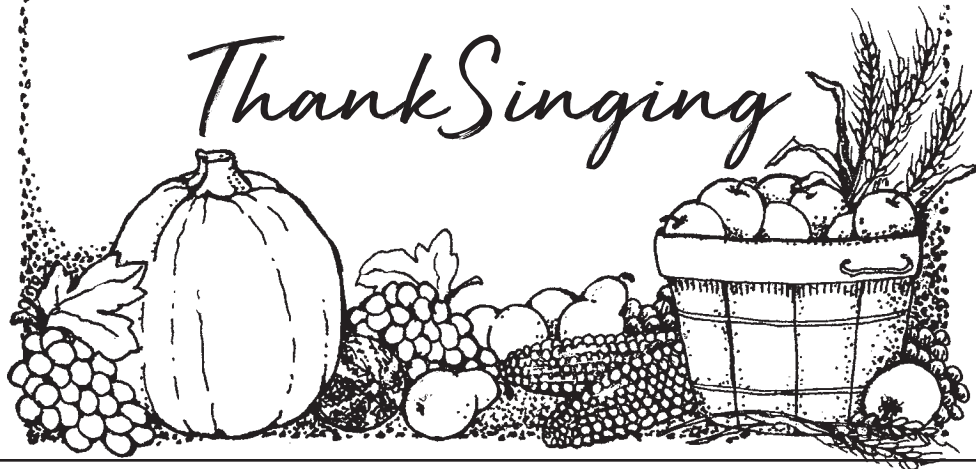

## Dwelling in Unity

*"Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell together in unity!" Psalm 133:1*

God wasn't kidding when he confounded the language of humanity at the Tower of Babel. But for one beautiful day on October 7 of this year, that dividing wall came down for the sixty-five women who assembled in our Fellowship Hall. We called the effort, "My Heart, Your Heart. . .United in Christ," and it truly was the Spirit of Jesus Christ that drew us together.

Because we love each other, we stood and hugged as many people as we could in one minute. We spent twenty minutes physically exercising together. We played together in a Rock, Paper, Scissors tournament and we sang and prayed in our two languages simultaneously.

Yet the bulk of our time was devoted to understanding how Satan enters our hearts to divide us and how Christ, so much greater than Satan, binds up our wounds and heals our hearts so we are free to love each other. We learned that. . .

- Satan whispers to each of us that we are Better Than all the jerks of the world. Christ declares that there is no one righteous, no not one. Each of us falls at the feet of the Lamb who was slain to claim his righteousness as our own.
- Satan whispers that we are Worse Than every other Christian. "In fact," he snarls, "you won't even make it at the Judgment Day. You are coming with me!" Christ stands with outstretched, nail-scarred hands and declares, "I have paid all debts for those who put their trust in me. They are forever mine!"
- Satan whispers that we Must Be Seen As "righteous," "flawless," "all together" by others and suggests a thick façade. Christ invites us to "come as you are" to allow his Spirit to transform us into his image.
- Satan whispers that You Deserve much more than the world has ever given you. But Christ models submission that "does not consider equality with. . ." as something to be grasped. He shows us how to empty ourselves for the good of others.

Satan would keep us "boxed in" to our fear of being wounded by others but Christ urges us to live in his Spirit of power, love and a sound mind.

We parted ways that day full of joy and also sadness. As we returned to our comfort zones we yearned for deeper relationship with our sisters of another tongue. By God's grace, we will experience more times like this here on this earth but, oh, how our hearts long for home!

Come, Lord Jesus, to take us home where there will be no sin, no suffering and no dividing walls between your children!
