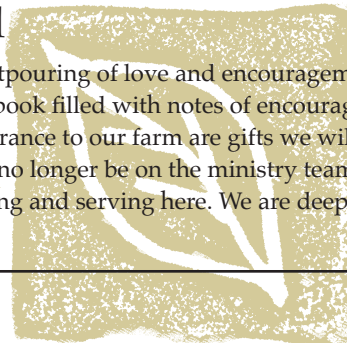

All You Need Is Love

Some of our White Station women recently had the opportunity to show love to the moms and children in the Agape FIT program. Families in Transition (FIT) is a transitional housing program dedicated to providing housing and support to homeless families and their children fleeing domestic violence.

In February, several women from White Station busily made cookies/desserts, set up tables, decorated the space for the moms/kids, and prepared the crafts for our guests. The FIT moms were treated to a quiet dinner complete with scores of delicious desserts. After they ate in the Fireplace Room, they were pampered with makeovers. These beaming moms were very appreciative to have this relaxing and enjoyable experience.
