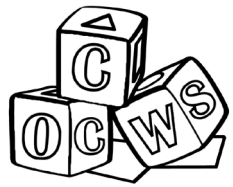

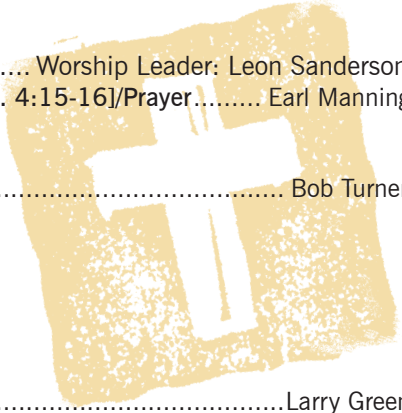

A Lifetime of Service

The Willoughby Christian Service Award was established in 2007 in honor of Pete and Lena Willoughby. White Station's leadership team has chosen to honor this couple for a life well lived in service to God by presenting this award each year in their name. This year's recipient is Bob Michie.

Megan Davey, one of Bob's daughters, shares these reflections of her Dad.

Some of our earliest memories (Megan, Trish, Mike and Susan) are going with our Dad to the church building when he would print the bulletin. We would sit at the light table to draw or just annoy him while he printed. I can still close my eyes and smell the ink and hear the rhythm of the suction cups picking up one page at a time – swoosh, swoosh, click, click – the paper would spin around the metal plates and gracefully be laid down flat. Dad was in constant motion, making sure the rollers were moving “just so” and checking ink levels, all the while showing me what they did, how it worked and keeping watch that I didn't get my fingers caught in anything.

My parents were always good stewards of their time and money. I think this is what allowed them to spend their time doing the work of the church without it being a “chore.” While Dad was printing and also helping with church finances, our Mom was busy creating felt boards and prepping for her Sunday School Class. Dad also served as a Deacon and was often at meetings for this or that. Doing the work of the church came first and I never heard them discuss whether it was an option or not.

I think now about how busy our lives are today and it amazes me that Dad served on the printing ministry team for as long as I can remember. We never heard our Mom or Dad complain about all they were in involved in at church. It was just something they did and still do today. We don't print our bulletins like we once did anymore, but they are still working at the church building almost every week. They even plan their vacations around the days when Dad does accounting work at the church.

I don't think our parents have ever thought about the number of hours given in volunteer work. It is just what they do, who they are. They continue to bless others through their quiet, humble service. Those who say that we're in a time when there are no heroes; they just don't know where to look.
