Introducing Ananias Moses

Botswana is in southern Africa, just north of the country of South Africa. It is home to many religions, and over 70% of its citizens profess to be religious. The country's main religions are Christianity and a traditional indigenous religion. The Church of Christ, or Phuthego ya ga Keresete as it is called in Botswana, has existed for about forty years. There are thirteen congregations in the entire country with a total membership of less than 1300.



Our newest missionary, Ananias Moses was born and raised in Botswana. In 2014, the Broadhurst Church of Christ in the capital of Gaborone, Botswana sent Ananias to Memphis to attend Harding School of Theology. He recently graduated with his Master's of Divinity degree and is returning home to Botswana to work with the Broadhurst congregation to evangelize and spread the message of Christ.

The ministry efforts of Ananias include preaching, teaching, discipling, mentoring, and benevolence. He also serves the community by facilitating health-related activities, particularly activities that sensitize and educate people about HIV / AIDS. The White Station Church of Christ is partnering with the Broadhurst Church of Christ in this work. The Global Missions Team is excited to have Ananias as part of the global outreach mission effort supported by the White Station congregation. May God's name be praised as Ananias serves the people of Botswana in this wonderful mission opportunity in his home country.

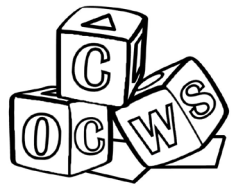

Paul identifies himself in Acts 22:3 as a student of Gamaliel, a famous and celebrated teacher among the Jews. Paul's critics and defenders started from the assumption that the man formerly known as Saul of Tarsus was well-educated. Surely, Paul's formal education in the holy scripture was a critical factor in his selection by the Lord for ministry to the early church.
