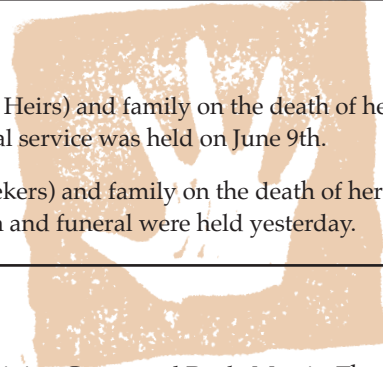
## Upcoming Baby Shower

For those who have been, it is one of the highlights of our time in Ghana. Worshipping in a congregation with hundreds of children praising God is quite an uplifting experience. The sweetness of their voices fills your heart with a deeper longing for heaven.

Next week we will be worshipping with Frank Hotorwoshie and his five villages in a combined worship service in Warababa. Warababa is a small primitive fishing village right on the beach. The church building consists of two and half walls and a roof. Its openness allows you to look out at the ocean and hear the majesty of God in the crashing waves as you sing praises alongside believers who sing in a language unfamiliar to your own. Hardworking, humble people who sing quietly, but with a deep love for their heavenly father.

Our last Sunday in Ghana, we will be worshipping with Courtney Garland and her precious Pearls - twenty-three teenage girls rescued from a life on the streets and given an education and hope for a better life. These girls worship from a place deep in their grateful hearts. Their energy is contagious and inviting. Worshipping with the Pearls truly fills one's heart with much joy and leaves a smile on your face.

Three very different types of worship. One very real God in common. The same God you will be worshipping today. Thank you, White Station, for your support - your many prayers, your generous giving, for eating our pancakes, and filling our trunks with school supplies.
