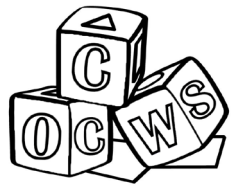

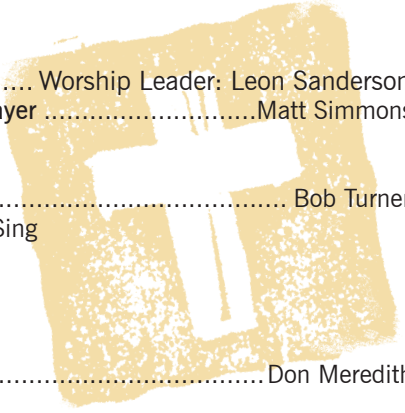

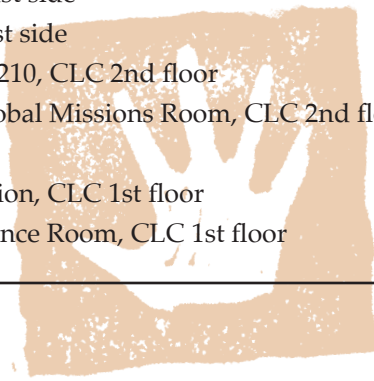

## Auditorium Chiller Special Contribution is Next Sunday!

A big thank you to all for your patience and understanding while the water chiller servicing the Auditorium is replaced and air conditioning is restored to that facility. Seven adult bible classes have been relocated to different classrooms on our campus as well as the Auditorium worship service relocated to the Children's Worship Room until the work is completed.

A lot has happened this past week as details of the plan to replace the water chiller for the Auditorium moves forward. The new chiller has been purchased and will be shipped this week. Companies that will rework the electrical power/controls, rework steel piping for the new chiller and a crane to lift the new chiller in place have all been secured and are ready to go.

Several months ago, the Budget Action Team began to review our budget for the new fiscal year that began on July 1st. There was a very intentional focus on the six lenses of our new Vision Statement when Ministry Leaders presented their plans for ministries at White Station, in our community and around the world.

Every ministry was viewed through the 6 lenses of our Vision Statement.

- Spiritual Growth
- Personal Connection
- Unity in Diversity
- Generational Exchange
- Valuing Families
- Missional Approach



What the Budget Action Team nor Vision Lenses could see coming, was the extraordinary expense of a 65 ton chiller for our Auditorium. To be sure, there are no plans to change our ministry budget because of this expense. We, the elders, believe in the Vision led ministry budget and there are no plans to change it because of a water chiller that needs to be replaced. We are also moving forward with the chiller purchase and the work to restore the air conditioning to the Auditorium.

However, the chiller expense is not budgeted. As a family, as a body, we now have the opportunity to participate in a special contribution toward funding the Auditorium air conditioning repair. We are planning a special contribution next Sunday, July 15th and are asking each family to consider what they can set aside to give toward this extraordinary expense. The goal is to offset as much of the approximate \$60,000 expense as God purposes in our hearts to give. The White Station church has long been a church that gives when there is a time of need. Even in this past fiscal year, Good Samaritans giving, the HST special contribution and special contribution for Mission Sunday, exceeded goals because of the way you've allowed His Spirit to move through your generous giving.

The body of Christ that meets at White Station continues to be a blessing to God's Kingdom through its overwhelming generosity to not only take care of "bricks and mortar", but more importantly, address the needs of this community, reflecting the Light of Christ in a dark world.

The elders at White Station thank you for your generosity and pray we will allow God and His Spirit to continue to lead as we navigate this challenge ahead. He always does.
