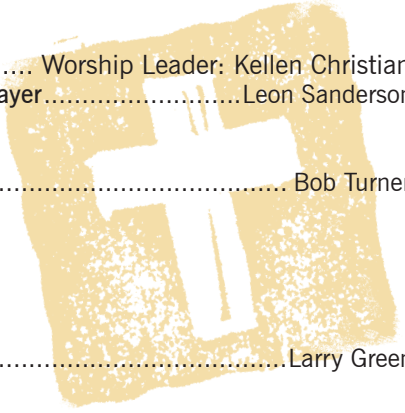

## Valuing Families

The really great thing about the six lenses that help us dig deeper into our vision, is that you get to look at any situation through each lens. I was recently reflecting on the lens of valuing families and started seeing things I hadn't before.

The number of you who consistently ask my wife and I about our kids is really neat. How are they doing? What are they up to? They are questions that show you really care and aren't just making small talk.

But, my little family is not really anything to get excited about when you consider it's routine at White Station to have names like Hendrix and Chester and Brown and Douglas and Elkins and Dennis and others I'm sure I've left out. I mean, in most congregations you expect to find at least a few families that span more than two generations, but there's a lot of you guys running around here! Aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, grandparents, and grandkids... Extended families find a home at White Station because they're valued here, and I like that.

One of the really neat things about family is just how flexible it is. You do not have to be a mother to be a mom. You do not have to be a father to be a dad. I have seen White Station be family for those who don't have one. So, don't let all this talk about huge families make you feel left out because even if you're the only one from your biological family within a thousand miles of Memphis, you have family here.

But the way White Station values families goes even deeper than that.

Most of us know that the youth ministry and the children's ministry here at White Station have had a trying couple of years due to certain circumstances and some other events. But the way I have seen YOU, our church family, surround those ministries and make sure those kids are cared for and loved and taught says a great deal about how important Valuing Families is here. Same thing goes for SOMA, the ministry to students on the U of M campus. Members of this congregation are consistently involved in the lives of college students and being family for them.

But the way White Station values families goes even deeper than that.

Being here each weekday affords me the opportunity to see just how many families White Station cares for, families that we don't even know. It's not uncommon for a mom and kids to make their way into our clothes closet. It's not unusual for one of us to take a food box out to somebody's car and there is a car seat in the back. You see, the lens of valuing family helps us see everything that we do in terms of the families that it impacts. But, nothing shows this quite as clearly as what goes on in room 102 over in the CLC building. Our Threads of Hope room supports foster families who are themselves trying to provide family for kids who don't have any. Now, that is really special.

Keep up the good work and may God be praised, after all, family was really His idea.
