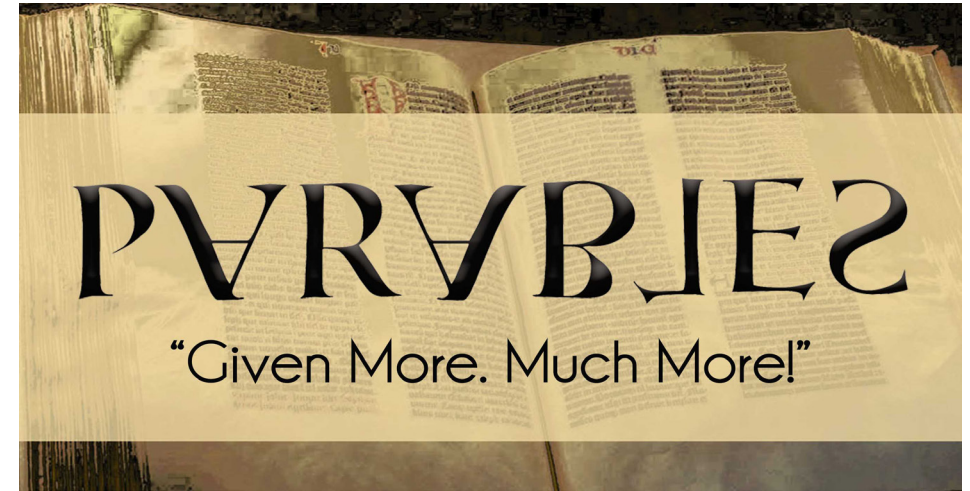

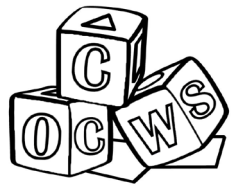

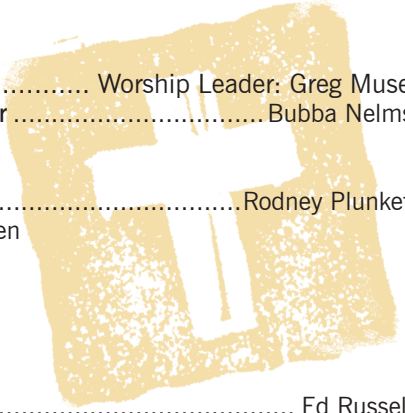

**Charis:** Moved to the Fireplace Room, West side

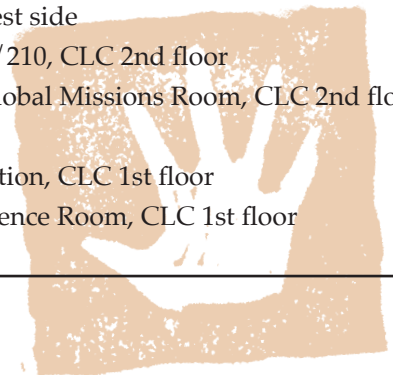
**Faith Walk Community:** Moved to G209/210, CLC 2nd floor

Yes, a family with two languages.

Again, we might have a hard time figuring out what it means to be one family despite all of the differences, but it is in the times of need when we demonstrate what it means to be a family.

Recently, the Nuñez family moved to Memphis. Victor, the father, has been living in Memphis for the last two years. He has been a huge blessing to Iglesia and to White Station. It was very hard for all of us to see him separated from his family. He repeatedly said, "I dream of the day that my wife and my girls can be here with me." After two years, their family was reunited: their visas were granted, and they were able to come to Memphis this month. White Station has been a huge part of all of this. They moved to their house and they had literally nothing, but many people from White Station donated almost everything that they needed to begin a new chapter in their lives. A chapter that starts here in Memphis. Victor and Rosa Nuñez said, "We miss our friends and family from Mexico, but God has blessed more than we thought through our White Station family. " Ultimately, this is what we mean by "we are one church, one family."
