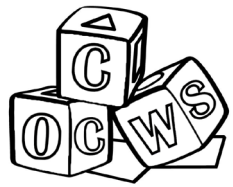

## Goodbye, Summer!

By tomorrow, school will be back in session for all our kids and we will have said good-bye to summer! Students are heading back into the classroom whether they are ready or not! As for Children's Ministry, we had a great summer! We loved being "Shipwrecked" for a week during VBS and learning Jesus rescues, tie-dying t-shirts, exercising with the community exercise class, baking cookies, and having special guests share their favorite Bible stories with us. We also loved having Audrey Lynn with us as our summer intern!

As we close out summer and think about what is ahead for the Fall, I want to give you some ways you can bless our students, but first I want to share a few numbers with you. Are you aware that our students spend an average of 900 – 1000 hours in class at their school each year depending on their age level? If we add extra curricular activities into the mix, you can quickly add another 100 plus hours! These same students spend 126 hours in our worship times, if they attend every Sunday (2 hours) and every Wednesday (1 hour) during the school year. Please don't hear me wrong, I realize that our worship is more than meeting at WS campus each week, but I wanted to give you a comparison number to think about!

So with those numbers in mind I want us to think about how much we need to use every opportunity we have to bless our children. I want our children to be lights in their school. No matter where they attend, public or private, they are given many different paths to choose from and as their church family it is important that we are active in their lives! Here are some things you can do to encourage and bless our kids:

- 1) Pray for our students daily.
- 2) Adopt a student and attend their extra curricular activities.
- 3) Write a note and mail it to them! Kids love getting mail.
- 4) Make arrangements and go eat lunch with a student.
- 5) Teach or help in a Bible class so you can build relationships with students.
- 6) Engage in conversations with our students when you see them in Worship.

It is my prayer that we will be a community that loves and shepherds our students well.
