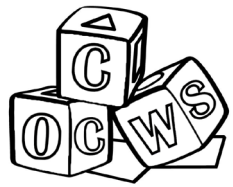

Wednesday Night Meals

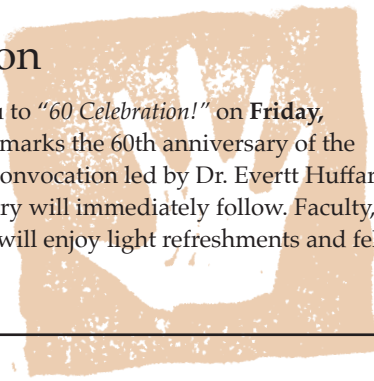

Friends from the Past

Recently I was surprised to find people from my past getting in touch with me. For example, in Birmingham, Alabama not too long ago, there was a newspaper interview with my brother Chuck Leavell who plays the piano for the Rolling Stones.

One man read this newspaper interview and recognized the name. He was a boy younger than myself when we lived next door to each other as kids in Birmingham in the 50s. He didn't really know Chuck because at the time Chuck was a small baby, but he knew me and wrote to Chuck asking about me. Chuck made a PDF of this man's letter and emailed it to me. So I wrote a letter to this man bringing him up to speed on the nearly 60 years since we last saw each other. In a few days, this man's sister also wrote me! He gave her my address.

This is an example of what has been happening to me lately. Last spring, one of my friends at what was then David Lipscomb College found my email address and sent me an email. We hadn't seen each other for maybe 35 years. We filled each other in on what had happened to us. Another man emailed me who was with me in high school. We did the same, filling each other in on what happened to us. Looks like there will be more in the months to come!

It is fascinating how we may not see each other for many years, then come into touch again. Our appearances may be altered by age, but we're still the same personalities we were years ago.

That makes me think about how we may age, but God is eternal. He remains the same year after year, even centuries and millenniums later with no change. I might become weak and feeble; I might forget my friends from the past, but God remains the same and was the God of my ancestors hundreds of years ago. And today He is also my God!

I can only put my trust in God and His Son. What about you?
