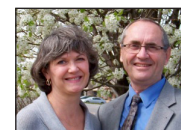
Celebrating Marriages

 The Kingdom is not only beyond our efforts, it is beyond our vision.*

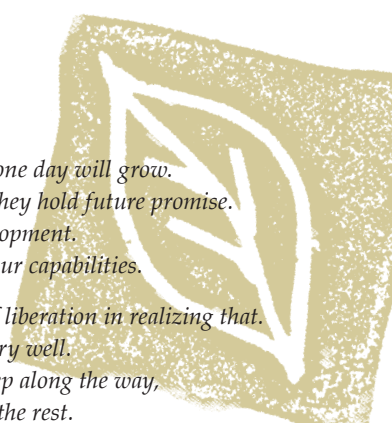

*No statement says all that could be said.  
 No prayer fully expresses our faith.

 No program accomplishes the church's mission.  
 No set goals and objectives includes everything.*

*This is what we are about: We plant seeds that one day will grow.

 We provide yeast that produces effects beyond our capabilities.*
