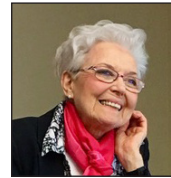
New Happenings in the CLC

The Seven Keys to the Aging of Christians

The 12th Annual Abundant Living Retreat was held last week in Branson, Missouri. Marilyn and I were present along with our good friend Earl Manning and about 230 other folks from 21 states. I presented morning devotionals and led worship several times. There were 12 speakers on various topics encouraging seniors. One of those was Howard Norton, veteran missionary, preacher, teacher and writer from Searcy, Arkansas. He shared 7 keys to the aging of Christians. They are worth noting here:

1. **Focus on the sunny side of life.** The seamy side is clearly visible and discouraging. However, there are moments and events around us that lift our spirits. Look for them and be thankful for them.
2. **We need to learn to be content with what we have.** If Paul was content in prison, we can be, too. [Philippians 4]
3. **Be "can do" people.** Let's train ourselves toward a positive response when opportunity arises. We may say "yes", "let me think on it" or we may suggest someone who may be able to help.
4. **Cherish old friends and make new ones.** There may be a few recluses in the world, but most of us are aware of the need for relationships with others in both good and bad times.
5. **Forgive our debtors.** This is Christ-like as he included this phrase in his model prayer. It is also mentally and emotionally healthy as grudges are too heavy to carry one step.
6. **Live life with a purpose.** This provides reason to get up every day. It is also clearly stated by Paul that we are "created in Christ Jesus for good works." [Ephesians 2:10]
7. **Turn your eyes upon Jesus.** Hebrews 12:2 teaches us to look to Jesus as we run the race. Remember the words of Helen Lemmel: "Turn your eyes upon Jesus, look full in His wonderful face, and the things of earth will grow strangely dim in the light of His glory and grace."
