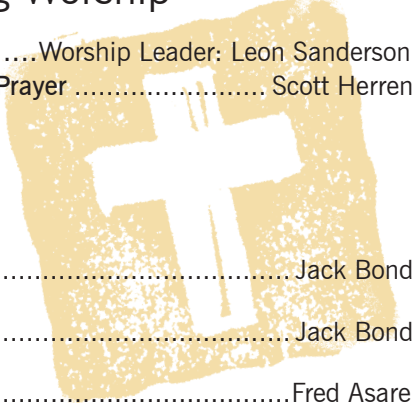

"Table to Table" Fall Food Drive Starts Today!

Food insecurity and hunger are a reality for every community in our nation, including Memphis. Whether it's the child who goes without a healthy snack after school, parents who go without dinner so their children can eat or the senior citizen who must have food for their medicine to work properly, every one needs adequate food and proper nutrition to stay healthy.

- White Station's bi-annual food drives provide over 250 boxes of food that are distributed to food insecure neighbors in our community.
- Over 700 boxes of food – almost 10 tons - are distributed to people in need who come through our Community Life Center doors annually.
- Your food donations and part of your monthly contribution to the Good Samaritans Ministry also fill boxes throughout the year.

Empty food boxes are located in all adult bible classes and worship venues this morning complete with food shopping lists and cards for a personal prayer, favorite scripture or word of encouragement for the family who will receive your food box in the coming months. Filled boxes can be returned to the lobby of your worship venue or the CLC over the next several Sundays where they will be picked up and made ready to bless a family in need.

By God's grace, your generous donations of food and financial gifts sustain the Food Pantry Ministry that serves our diverse community providing a most important fundamental need of neighbors who are hungry.
