**Trick or Treat a Trunk 2018**

Last Sunday we hosted our annual Trick or Treat a Trunk event. Every year I get asked, "How many people do you think are here?" The question continues throughout the week and the truth of the matter, I could not even begin to tell you! For those that need a number, most would estimate around 1,000 but I truly do not have a way to know.

However, what I do know is this event could not happen without this church family being so generous and involved! Here are the numbers that bless and impress me the most: 35 people signed up to bring hotdogs, 43 people signed up to bring hotdog buns, 40 people signed up to bring chips, 49 people signed up to bring water, 46 people signed up to host a trunk, 3 people cooked over 1,000 hotdogs, 7 people wrapped the hotdogs, 8 people served food to our guests, and 5 people were greeters.

Within those numbers, many are represented more than once because they brought or participated in more than one item. However, I can tell you the list represents 135 different individuals! I can also tell you it does not include all the family members, youth and college students that participated in hosting a trunk. If I added those numbers to the 135, I am 100% confident in telling you we had over 200 people that made Trick or Treat a success! In my mind, that is the number we need to be celebrating! Yes, I am thankful for the community members who attended, and it is my prayer that God will use this event to impact their lives. But how amazing is it that we are a part of a church family that loves our community enough that more than 200 people came together to show them they are loved and welcomed!

I am thankful to each of you who participated. I wish I could list each of you by name and tell you how thankful I am for the way you blessed our night!

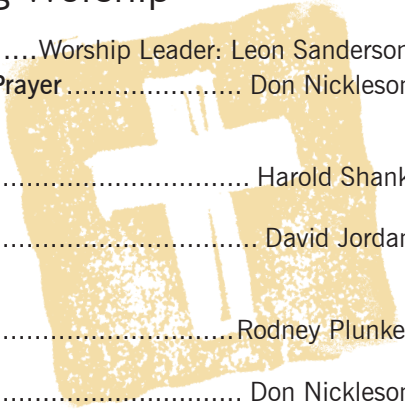

Filled boxes can be returned to the lobby of your worship venue or the CLC over the next several Sundays where they will be picked up and made ready to bless a family in need this holiday.

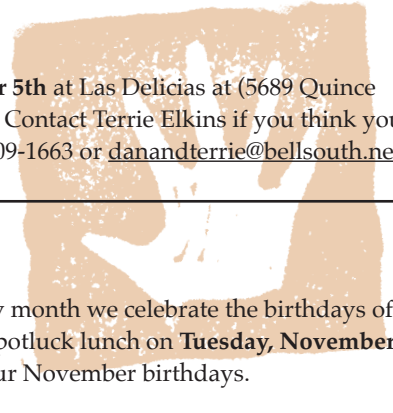
### Open Ministry Coordinator Position
