Upcoming Baby Shower

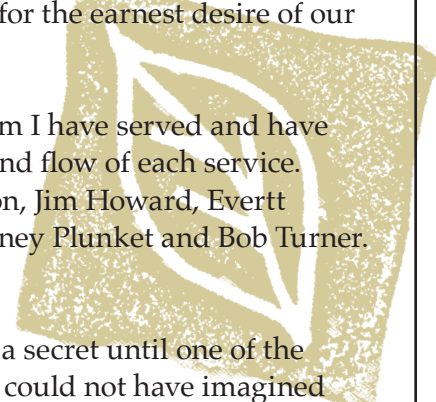
