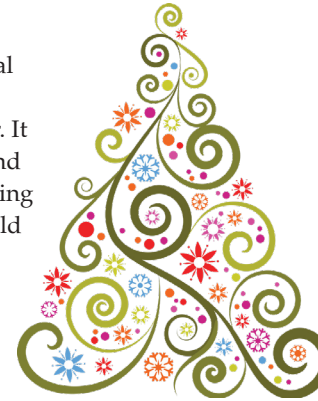

Survey Next Sunday, November 17th

Next Sunday, November 17th, the White Station body will be asked to complete a brief, but very important survey as a part of our worship. The purpose of this survey is to understand where we at White Station are regarding matters of race and racial justice so to know where we might begin our journey together for matters of biblical justice and righteousness. Beginning in January, Rodney Plunket and Bob Turner will preach sermons focused on these very important matters.

As background, most of your elders, ministry team and spouses, along with a number of other members (totaling approximately 50) were blessed to be a part of an intentional study on race, racism and racial justice last September and October, led by Dr. Duane Loynes. This five-series training/meetings led to the development of a Racial Justice Team, who has worked diligently for the past year, which included leading your elders and ministry team in scripture, outside readings and processing matters of racial justice, together.
