9:30 a.m. - In the Auditorium

- This worship service will be in the more contemporary worship style of the Fellowship Hall inclusive of women serving in leadership roles.
- This service will also be our live streamed service, so come early as we will be starting on time at **exactly 9:30 a.m.**
- Families will be safely positioned 12 feet apart.
- This service will include communion (individually packaged).
- No Sunday school classes, children's activities, or nursery will be provided.

11:00 a.m. - In the Auditorium

- This service will include communion (individually packaged).
